

The idea for an open studios event in Oxford was first mulled over around a kitchen table four decades ago. The first Artweek was held the following spring, a small local event and the first of its kind in the UK. Since then, millions of visitors have enjoyed the friendly welcome of Oxfordshire artists, and now the festival is many times bigger encompassing every corner of the county. Today you'll find both open studios and pop-up galleries in an array of amazing places. The ethos, however, remains the same; artists and makers open their doors and welcome. for free, anyone who would like to see their art, their studios and chat about their work and inspiration. All visitors need is a touch of curiosity.

Pop-up exhibitions are often an easy way to discover the hidden talent of a collection of artists in a single space, whilst a visit to an artist's studio can offer a more in-depth insight into an artist's practice. If a picture tells a thousand words then a studio is an epic adventure!

Entering a studio is like opening a window into an artist's world to see the way they work, their materials, their tools, their processes, sketchbooks and their work in progress. In this almost mythical space the real and the imagined, great ideas and quiet reflection are drawn together with an artist's chosen craft and astonishing skill. Combined they bring forth the marvellous, the unique or the unexpected in a myriad of different ways, on canvas, through a lens, in a design or as an installation.

Explore one-off-venues, city streets and village trails and you'll find beauty, both aesthetically and in the way that art makes us feel or think. Amongst these pages you'll also find multidisciplinary practitioners pushing their creative boundaries to question or even change the world around us and community exhibitions in which participants have used art to work through their own challenges.



Artweeks is about so much more than simply the art, craft and design on show. It is about the 2000 people who have created it and the stories they have to share, and we hope that together Artweeks will continue to foster creativity, in thought and artistic practice in both the artist community and among its visitors for many years to come.

The Mary Moser Award 2022

Introducing David Williams

Stone carver David Williams is the winner of the 2022 Artweeks Mary Moser Award, an annual prize established to honour Mary Moser's commitment to Artweeks and to further the career of a professional artist who has taken up their craft as a second career later in life.

David began stone carving about eight years ago when he was given some stone-carving chisels one Christmas. Most of his pieces are inspired by nature, either echoing the shapes he sees or else carved in a stylised way. Recent work has included big sections of sunflowers nearly a metre across in offcuts of Ancaster limestone, sleek tactile owls which have an elegant globular form and gilded pebbles to fit – literally – every pocket.

David has increasingly devoted himself to what started as a hobby and has become a way of life. He now also teaches day-workshops for people who would like to have a go at stone carving.
