

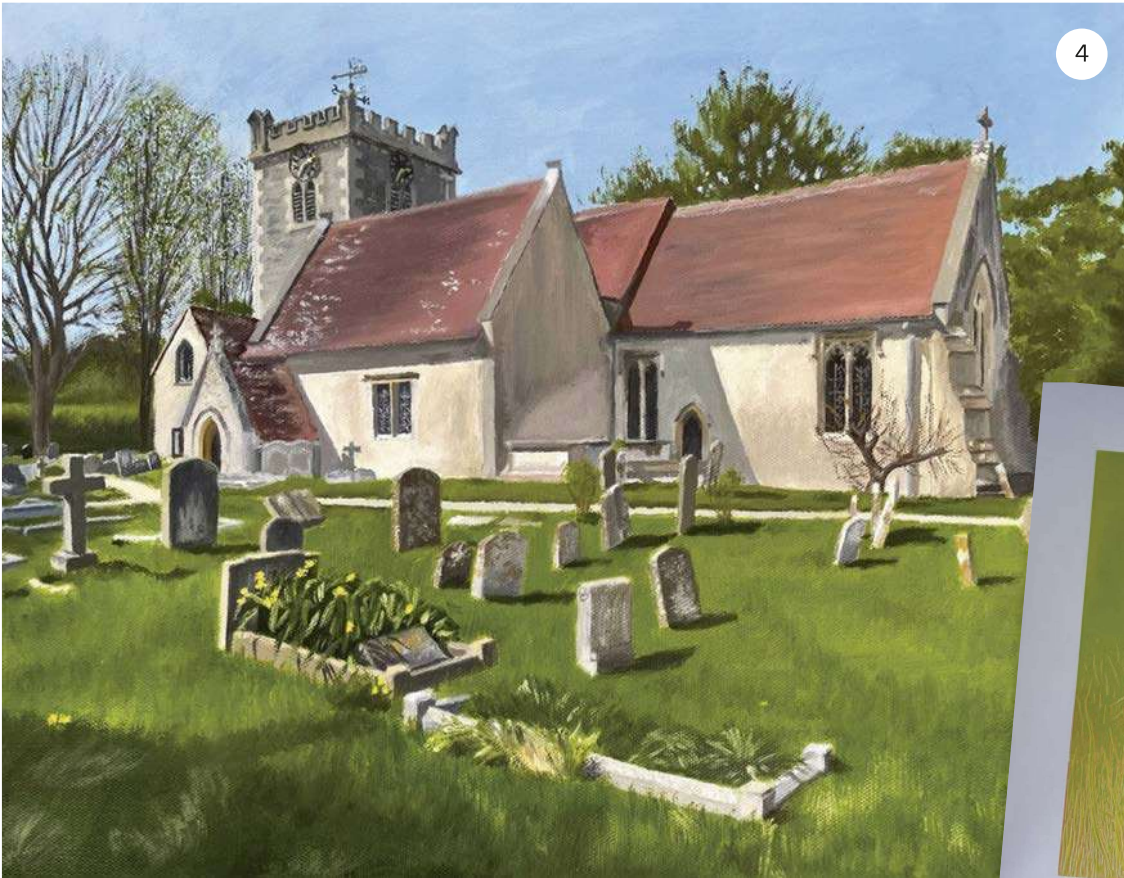

- 3** Enodia Watching by **Ellis Stacey** (Artweeks listing 264; Oxford) Wooden sculpture in oak and cherry, £550



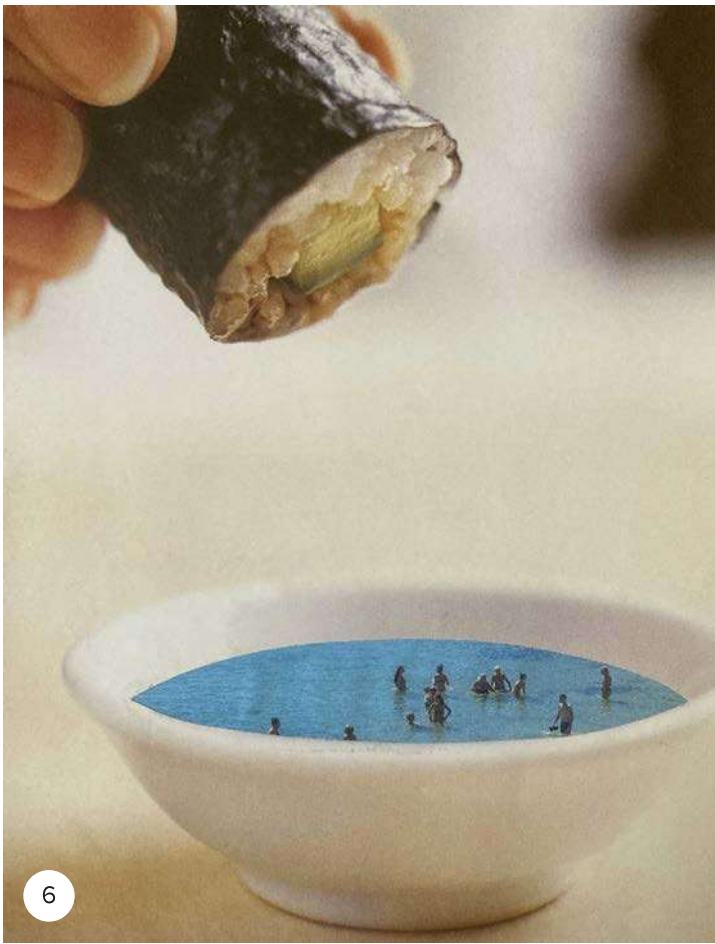

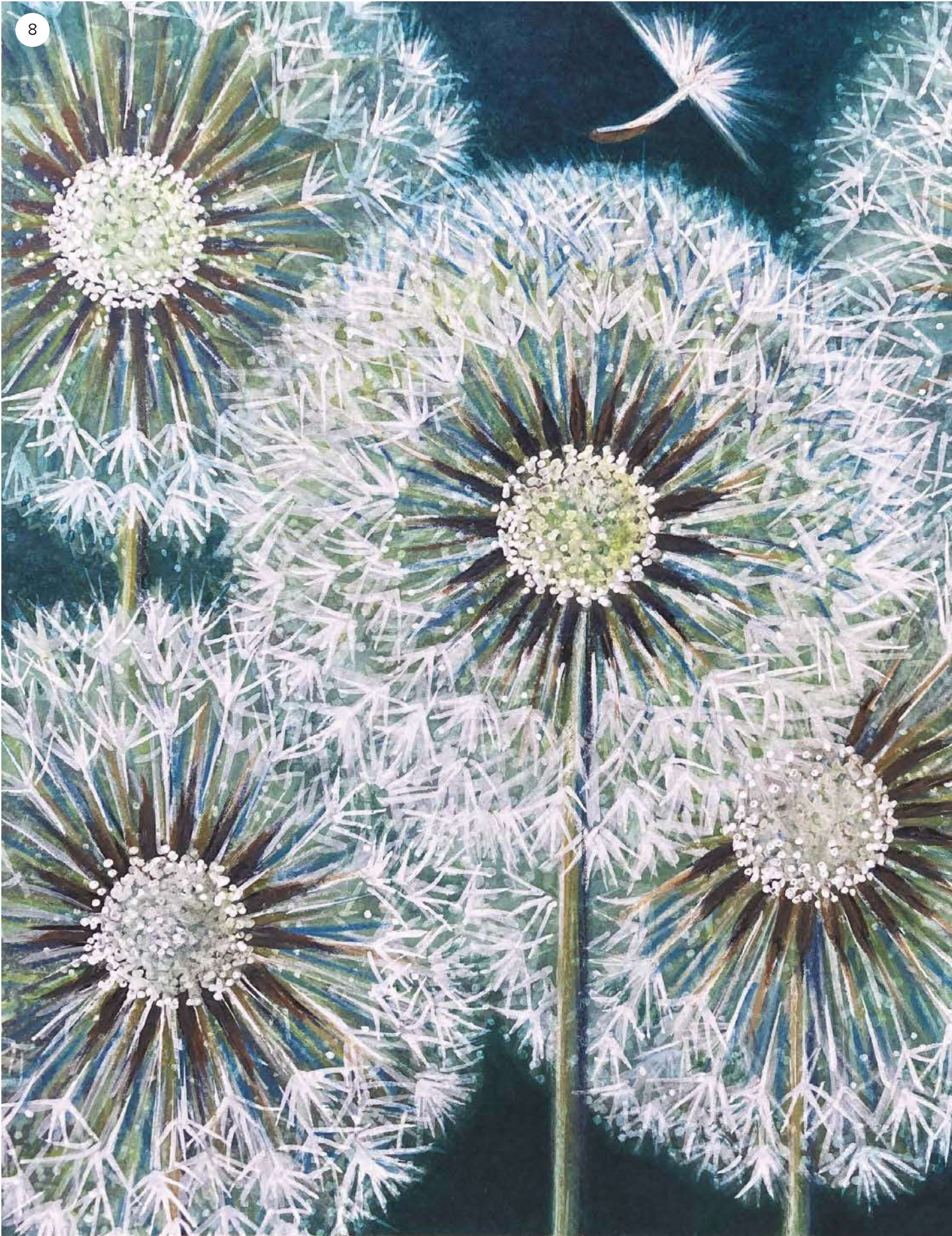

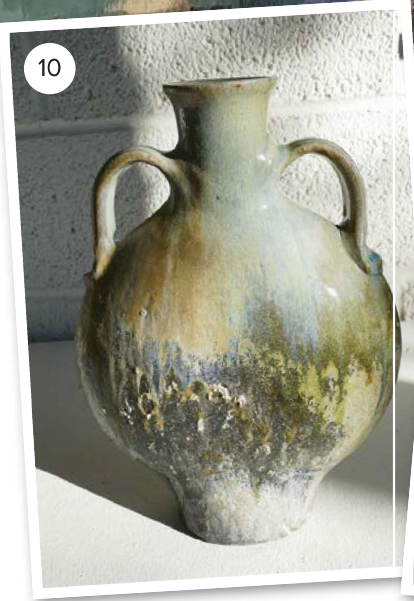
