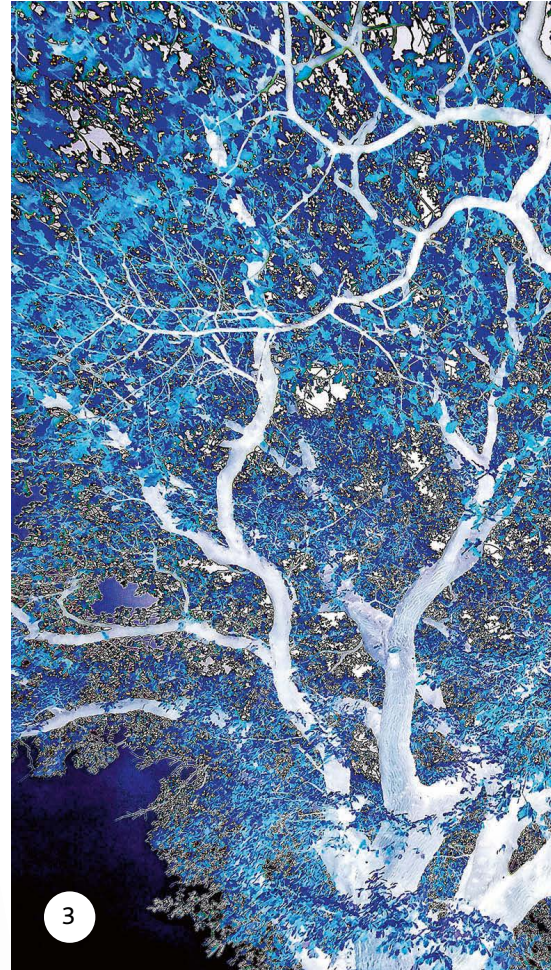
1. Spring Sunshine at Youlbury by Rosie Taylor, acrylics on canvas, £295





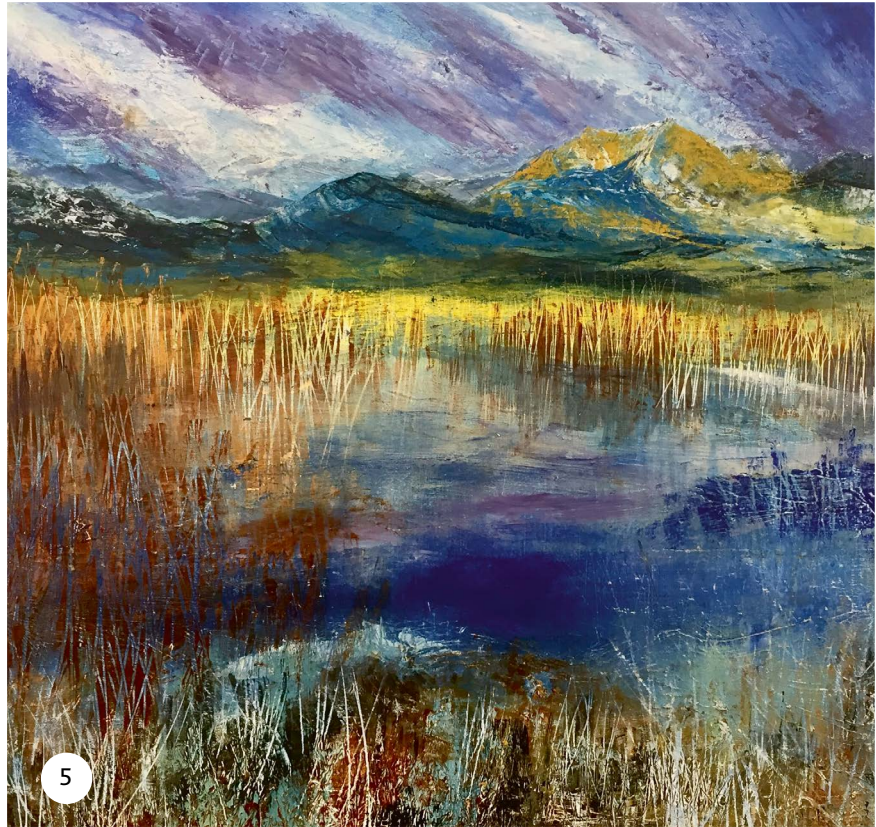
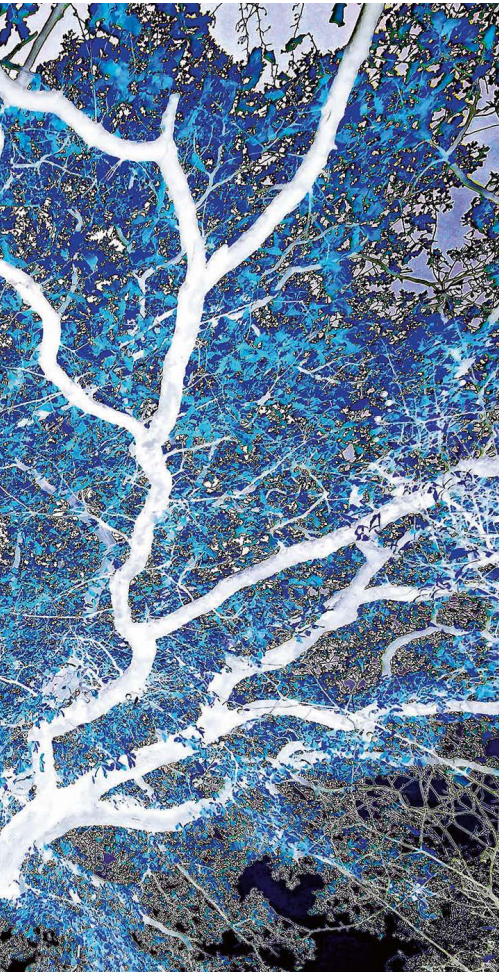
2. Boiled Eggs and Soldiers by Mark 'Lino' Lord is a signed and editioned lino print, £25 print only or £100 framed.

4. Crocus 2, is a pigment ink print of a photograph by Caroline Hyman, £300.

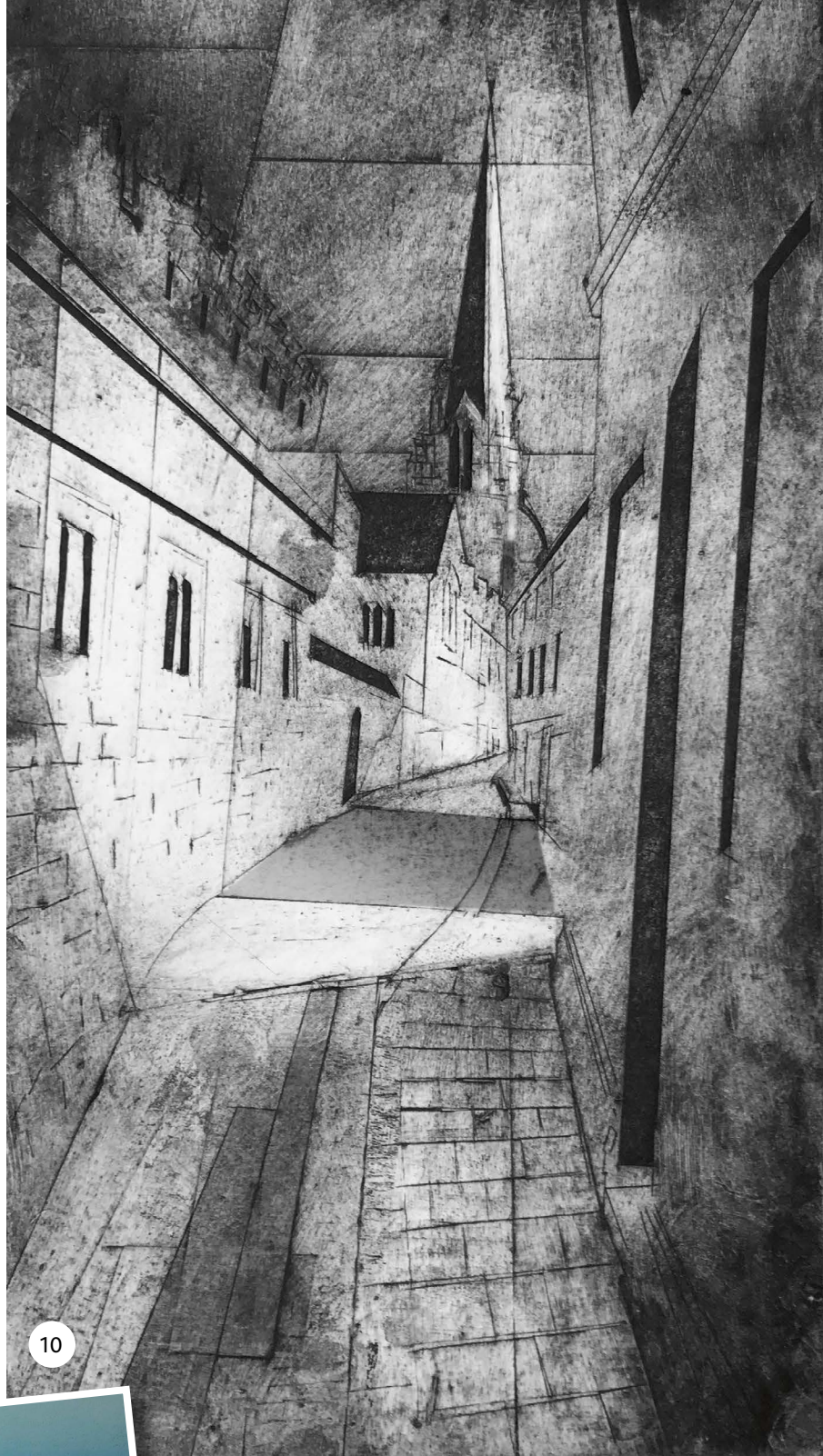




5. Blue Water is a mixed media painting by Jessica Parker, £350
